OUR JUDGES

Mrs. Kristie Wheeler

In 1971, I purchased my first AKC reg. afghan hound for \$135.00. Over the next 25 years, Zuran Afghans held the distinction of consistently producing Best in Show, International and Specialty winning dogs with top rankings in many countries. Some of those dogs still hold unbroken records. Afghans were always our main focus but other breeds came & went over the years; Salukis, Whippets, Pharoah Hounds (prior to recognition), Vizslas, Eng. Setters, WPGs, Ibizans, Min Pins, IGs, & Poms. When, because of health issues, I found myself unable to run in the ring anymore, Boston Terriers and then Chihuahuas became our focus. As a professional handler, I (along with my husband, Vern) have campaigned countless top Chihuahuas, Boston Terriers & other smaller breeds. We actively breed both Chihuahuas and Boston Terriers and continue to be top breeders & producers of quality examples in both.

Mr. David L. Frei

David Frei is well-known to millions of television viewers as the longtime co-host of USA Network's annual telecast of the popular **Westminster Kennel Club Dog Show**. In 2009, David co-hosted the live Westminster coverage from New York's Madison Square Garden for the 20th consecutive year. In connection with that role, he has made many appearances on *The Today Show*, *Good Morning America*, *The Early Show*, *Ellen*, *The View*, *Martha Stewart*, *Charlie Rose*, and more. He has been director of communications for the Westminster Kennel Club since 2003.

David also has been co-host on NBC of **The National Dog Show presented by Purina** on Thanksgiving Day since its inception in 2002, a telecast seen by about 20 million viewers every year. A longtime breeder-owner-handler and judge in the world of purebred dogs, he has enjoyed much competitive success with his Afghan Hounds and Brittanys. **Ch. Stormhill's Who's Zoomin Who** was the #1 Afghan in 1989 and retired as the top-winning female in the history of the breed. David has also exhibited his Brittanys in conformation and field trials. But he is most proud that Teigh, Belle and their "little sister," a Cavalier King Charles Spaniel named Angel, are wonderful therapy dogs, visiting patients and families with David at the Ronald McDonald House of New York and at Memorial Sloan Kettering Cancer Center.

With Westminster, David helped to create **Angel On A Leash**, a charitable activity supporting a therapy dog program at the Morgan Stanley Children's Hospital of New York-Presbyterian. **Angel On A Leash** (www.angelonaleash.org) is now an independent 501(c)(3) charity with David serving as president/CEO, and has expanded into a number of additional facilities across the country, including the Ronald McDonald House of New York City, St. Jude's Children's Research Hospital in Memphis, Memorial Sloan Kettering Cancer Center in New York, and Providence Health Care in Portland (Oregon).

David is a member of the Sports Council of the St. Jude Children's Research Hospital, a past director of Take The Lead, and past president of the Afghan Hound Club of America.

He is the co-author, with Mike Lingenfelter, of **The Angel By My Side**, a critically-acclaimed best seller about Mike's heroic service dog (www.angelbmyside.com). This book captured two separate Book of the Year Awards from the Dog Writers Association of America in 2003. David also was named winner of the DWAA's Distinguished Service Award in 2009, sponsored by the American Kennel Club.

David also does volunteer work with Transfiguration Church and School in New York's Chinatown, and in 2006 was honored by the Transfiguration Education Association with a special award for "his loyal support of Transfiguration Schools and his dedication to philanthropic causes."

In 2004, he appeared in one of the final episodes of the HBO hit series, **Sex And The City**, playing a dog show judge awarding a big win to Charlotte and her Cavalier.

Previously, he held public relations positions with the Denver Broncos, San Francisco 49ers and ABC-TV Sports in New York. A native of Oregon, he owned two very unique and popular sports bar restaurants in Seattle, as well as his own public relations agency, before moving to New York City in 2002.



The owner of a dog entered in this show is entirely responsible for any error in the entering of his dog, regardless of how, or by whom the entry was made.

There will be no refunds on overpayments or duplicate entries

CLASSIFICATIONS

The following CKC classes (divided by sex) will be provided:

Junior Puppy	for dogs 6 months of age but under 9 months of age
Senior Puppy	for dogs 9 months of age but under 12 months of age
12-18 Months	for dogs 12 months of age but under 18 months of age
Canadian Bred	for dogs born in Canada; champions in any country excluded
Bred By Exhibitor	for dogs owned and handled in the ring by the breeder
Open	for all dogs.
Veteran	for any dog, 7 years of age or older on the day of the show. These dogs do not compete for Winners, but the winner of this class shall go on to compete for Best of Breed. DOGS COMPETING IN THIS CLASS MAY BE SPAYED OR NEUTERED.
Specials Only	dogs which are <u>registered individually</u> , in the records of the Canadian Kennel Club or have a CKC ERN number and have attained Canadian Championship status may be entered in the "Specials Only" class. Entry of a dog in "Specials Only" is not prohibited on the grounds that the title of champion has not been confirmed by the CKC, but if it is found later that the dog had not attained championship status before the entry had been made, then all awards attained at the show will be cancelled. The entry of a 'listed' dog in Specials Only is not allowed.
Exhibition Only (6mo. +).....	for all dogs over 6 months of age and eligible for registration with the Canadian Kennel Club
Exhibition Only (3 – 6 mo)	puppies 3 – 6 months of age may be entered in Exhibition Only 3-6 Months provided the owner(s) has entered a dog in a Regular Official Class. <u>These Puppies may not participate in any regular, non-regular or unofficial classes or parades.</u>

SWEEPSTAKES CLASSES

TO COMPETE IN THE JUVENILE SWEEPSTAKES CLASS, DOGS MUST BE ENTERED IN A REGULAR CLASS, OR FOR SPECIALS ONLY. ENTRY FROM THE EXHIBITION ONLY CLASS IS NOT ALLOWED.

SIRE & GET

Stud dog and two or more of his get, not necessarily owned by the same owner.

DAM & PROGENY

Brood bitch and two or more of her progeny, not necessarily owned by the same owner.

BRACE

Two dogs of one breed, (either sex or mixed) not necessarily owned by the same owner

PARADE CLASSES

PARADE OF VETERANS

for dogs who are 7 years of age or older. Spayed or neutered dogs may be entered.

PARADE OF DUAL TITLE HOLDERS

for dogs holding titles in 2 or more fields of endeavour (conformation, coursing, obedience, scent hurdle racing, agility, flyball, etc.)

Please note: An exhibitor has the right to withdraw an entry up to the closing date and time as published in the premium list. This may be done by telephone but written or electronic notification must be received by the Show Secretary no later than entry closing date (8.7.1 Dog Show Rules). If written notification is not received by that time, the dog will remain entered in the show.

GENERAL INFORMATION

1. Dog Show Rulebooks and Obedience Trial regulations are available from the Canadian Kennel Club. Cost is \$6.42 per copy.
2. The Show Superintendent will be in full charge of the show which will be governed by CKC rules. All rules and regulations, as outlined in the Alberta Kennel Club premium list, will also apply to this Specialty.
3. Entries will be acknowledged after entry closing, with receipt, judging schedule and exhibitor passes. If such acknowledgement is not received one week before the show date, please contact the Show Secretary.
4. "It shall be the duty and obligation of the show-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer or any participant at an event held under these rules is not subject to indignities" – CKC rule book, Section 19.7.

ATTENTION ALL FOREIGN EXHIBITORS

Effective Jan/1992 all dogs that are foreign-born and foreign-owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC (Canadian Kennel Club) events will no longer require a CKC registration number but will require an ERN - Event Registration Number. This ERN does not register a dog with CKC for breeding purposes as defined in the Animal Pedigree Act but rather enables a foreign-owned dog to be awarded titles by the Canadian Kennel Club. Each dog must have its own number. To obtain an ERN, mail or fax a photocopy of the dog's foreign registration certificate with cheque or VISA/Mastercard number (expiry date, cardholder's name and signature). Provide your complete address for return of the ERN to you. **Cost is \$58.85.** ERN MUST BE APPLIED FOR WITHIN 30 DAYS OF FIRST DAY OF ENTERING A CKC EVENT.

Extrads From CKC Dog Show Rules

Chapter 8 Entries and End of Show
Section 8.2.5 An error in the class, date of birth or sex may be amended on the entry form up to one hour before the start of the show.

Section 8.3.1 Entries: Every dog entered in a Championship show must be one of the following:

- registered with the CKC, b) have an Event Registration Number, c) be eligible for registration with the CKC, or d) if it belongs to a listed breed it must have a Miscellaneous Certification Number (MCN).

Section 8.4.1 Listed Dogs: If a dog is not registered as in 8.3.1 (a) or (b) but is eligible for registration with the CKC, it may be entered at a show as a listed dog provided:

- that if born in Canada, it is eligible for individual registration;
- that if not born in Canada, it is eligible for registration in the records of the CKC;
- that if it is a foreign born and owned dog, an Event Registration Number or CKC registration number is obtained from the CKC within 30 days of the first show entered.

Section 8.4.2 Entry of a listed dog at a show must be accompanied by a listing fee as set by the Board in addition to the regular entry fee.

Section 8.5.1 Acceptance of Entries: If indicated in the premium list, an electronically transmitted entry may be accepted provided the entry is accompanied by a credit card charge authorization.

Section 8.5.3 No entry shall be accepted from or on behalf of any person who is officially known to be expelled, deprived of privileges, debarred or suspended by the CKC or any other registering body for pure bred dogs.

Section 8.5.4 After entries close, no further entries may be accepted, cancelled or substituted other than as otherwise stated in this section or as provided for in case of a postal strike.

Section 8.6.1 Refusal of Entries: The authorities of any show may:

- decline to accept entries for just cause, and/or
- refuse to receive or may remove any dog from the show building on account of disease or viciousness.
- in the case of non-acceptance, refund the fee with the reason for non-acceptance.

Section 8.8.2 Fees: Tendering of a dishonoured cheque or declined credit card in payment of an entry fee shall be considered non-payment of said fee and is an offense punishable by disciplinary action and cancellation of awards.

Section 8.9.1 Moving a Dog to Specials: A dog which is individually registered in the records of the CKC or that has a Miscellaneous Certification Number (MCN) and has completed the requirements for a Championship in accordance with these rules but at the time of the closing of entries for a show has not received confirmation of the title, may be transferred from one of the regular classes to Specials Only providing the transfer is submitted to the Show Secretary in writing by the owner or handler at least one hour prior to the opening of the show.

Section 8.9.2 It is established that a dog transferred to Specials Only has not completed the Championship requirements, all awards will be canceled and all ribbons and prizes won shall be forfeited. The owner may also be subject to disciplinary action.

Section 8.9.3 When one or more All-Breed and/or Specialty Shows are held on the same day, in the same venue, the request for moving of class dogs to Specials must be made a minimum of one hour prior to the scheduled start of the show for which the dog is being moved up to.

Chapter 4 Judges Section 4.1.3 A judge officiating at a show held under these rules shall not be subjected to indignities of any kind during the progress of the show. It shall be the duty and obligation of the club holding the show to see that this rule is effectively carried out.

Section 4.1.6 No person may approach a judge either directly or otherwise, orally or in writing, to favor his entry. Disciplinary action will be taken against any person who violates this rule or against a judge who fails to report any contravention of this rule to the CKC within 14 days of the act.

Chapter 14 Disqualifying or Excusing Dogs

Section 14.1.4 Once a dog has been disqualified for any reason at a conformation show, it may not be entered or shown at another show until the dog has been reinstated by the CKC. All awards earned by a dog shown in violation of this section will be cancelled by the CKC and the owner of the dog is subject to disciplinary action. Note: for information on reinstatement, see Chapter 14 Section 14.3 of the Dog Show Rules.

Championship Points and Cancellations

Section 15.1.1 A dog awarded Winners at a conformation show shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0 to 5) and the number of championship points credited to a dog awarded Winners shall be as provided hereunder.

Section 15.1.2 The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points awarded Winners shall be as follows:

Dogs competing*	1	2	3-	6-	10-	13 & more
Points allocated	0	1	2	3	4	5

*Includes the dog awarded Winners.

In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge shall be included in the calculation for championship points.

Section 15.1.3 If a Dog awarded Winners is also awarded Best of Breed then at the show all dogs competing in the breed, including Specials Only, shall be included in the total.

Section 15.1.4 If a Dog awarded Winners is also awarded Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed, then all dogs of the same sex including those competing for Specials Only shall be included in the total.

Section 15.1.5 If a Dog awarded Winners is also awarded Best of Winners, then all dogs defeated directly or indirectly in the breed shall be included in the total.

Section 15.1.6 If a dog is awarded Winners only, then all the dogs of the same sex in the class competition shall be included in the total.

Section 15.1.7 The number of championship points to be credited to a dog awarded Winners shall be determined by the highest award earned and calculated as per this section.

Clarification: Example of directly or indirectly defeating: If the Winners Bitch is awarded Best of Opposite Sex but not Best of Winners, the Best of Winners Male shall be deemed to have indirectly defeated the Specials Bitches, and is thus entitled to add them to the number of dogs and bitches defeated.

Section 15.1.8 In addition to championship points allocated at the breed level, a dog awarded Winners which also places in the regular Group competition shall be credited with the following additional points provided that the dog was defeated at the Group level.

Section 15.1.9 A dog may not be credited with more than 5 championship points in a single show.

Section 15.1.10 A breed or class shall not be allowed more than 2 sets of championship points per sex on any day in the same venue.

Section 15.1.11 A dog awarded Winners which also places Best in Show at an all-breed conformation show shall be credited with 5 championship points inclusive of any points earned at the breed and group level.

Section 15.1.12 In order for a dog to be recognized as a Champion and its owner provided with a Championship Certificate, the dog must:

- earn at least 10 championship points under at least 3 different judges; and,
- be registered in the records of the CKC, have an Event Registration Number (ERN), or have a Miscellaneous Certification Number (MCN)
- have earned at least one 2 point win either at the breed or group level.

Extracts From CKC Dog Show Rules

Chapter 8 Entries and End of Show
Section 8.2.5 An error in the class, date of birth or sex may be amended on the entry form up to one hour before the start of the show.

Section 8.3.1 Entries: Every dog entered in a Championship show must be one of the following:

- registered with the CKC, b) have an Event Registration Number, c) be eligible for registration with the CKC, or d) if it belongs to a listed breed it must have a Miscellaneous Certification Number (MCN).

Section 8.4.1 Listed Dogs: If a dog is not registered as in 8.3.1 (a) or (b) but is eligible for registration with the CKC, it may be entered at a show as a listed dog provided:

- that if born in Canada, it is eligible for individual registration;
- that if not born in Canada, it is eligible for registration in the records of the CKC;
- that if it is a foreign born and owned dog, an Event Registration Number or CKC registration number is obtained from the CKC within 30 days of the first show entered.

Section 8.4.2 Entry of a listed dog at a show must be accompanied by a listing fee as set by the Board in addition to the regular entry fee.

Section 8.5.1 Acceptance of Entries: If indicated in the premium list, an electronically transmitted entry may be accepted provided the entry is accompanied by a credit card charge authorization.

Section 8.5.3 No entry shall be accepted from or on behalf of any person who is officially known to be expelled, deprived of privileges, debarred or suspended by the CKC or any other registering body for pure bred dogs.

Section 8.5.4 After entries close, no further entries may be accepted, cancelled or substituted other than as otherwise stated in this section or as provided for in case of a postal strike.

Section 8.6.1 Refusal of Entries: The authorities of any show may:

- decline to accept entries for just cause, and/or
- refuse to receive or may remove any dog from the show building on account of disease or viciousness.
- in the case of non-acceptance, refund the fee with the reason for non-acceptance.

Section 8.8.2 Fees: Tendering of a dishonoured cheque or declined credit card in payment of an entry fee shall be considered non-payment of said fee and is an offense punishable by disciplinary action and cancellation of awards.

Section 8.9.1 Moving a Dog to Specials: A dog which is individually registered in the records of the CKC or that has a Miscellaneous Certification Number (MCN) and has completed the requirements for a Championship in accordance with these rules but at the time of the closing of entries for a show has not received confirmation of the title, may be transferred from one of the regular classes to Specials Only providing the transfer is submitted to the Show Secretary in writing by the owner or handler at least one hour prior to the opening of the show.

Section 8.9.2 It is established that a dog transferred to Specials Only has not completed the Championship requirements, all awards will be canceled and all ribbons and prizes won shall be forfeited. The owner may also be subject to disciplinary action.

Section 8.9.3 When one or more All-Breed and/or Specialty Shows are held on the same day, in the same venue, the request for moving of class dogs to Specials must be made a minimum of one hour prior to the scheduled start of the show for which the dog is being moved up to.

Chapter 4 Judges Section 4.1.3 A judge officiating at a show held under these rules shall not be subjected to indignities of any kind during the progress of the show. It shall be the duty and obligation of the club holding the show to see that this rule is effectively carried out.

Section 4.1.6 No person may approach a judge either directly or otherwise, orally or in writing, to favor his entry. Disciplinary action will be taken against any person who violates this rule or against a judge who fails to report any contravention of this rule to the CKC within 14 days of the act.

Chapter 14 Disqualifying or Excusing Dogs

Section 14.1.4 Once a dog has been disqualified for any reason at a conformation show, it may not be entered or shown at another show until the dog has been reinstated by the CKC. Section 15.1.3 If a Dog awarded Winners is also awarded Best of Breed then at the show all dogs competing in the breed, including Specials Only, shall be included in the total.

Section 15.1.4 If a Dog awarded Winners is also awarded Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed, then all dogs of the same sex including those competing for Specials Only shall be included in the total.

Section 15.1.5 If a Dog awarded Winners is also awarded Best of Winners, then all dogs defeated directly or indirectly in the breed shall be included in the total.

Section 15.1.6 If a dog is awarded Winners only, then all the dogs of the same sex in the class competition shall be included in the total.

Section 15.1.7 The number of championship points to be credited to a dog awarded Winners shall be determined by the highest award earned and calculated as per this section.

Clarification: Example of directly or indirectly defeating: If the Winners Bitch is awarded Best of Opposite Sex but not Best of Winners, the Best of Winners Male shall be deemed to have indirectly defeated the Specials Bitches, and is thus entitled to add them to the number of dogs and bitches defeated.

Section 15.1.8 In addition to championship points allocated at the breed level, a dog awarded Winners which also places in the regular Group competition shall be credited with the following additional points provided that the dog was defeated at the Group level.

- earn at least 10 championship points under at least 3 different judges; and,
- be registered in the records of the CKC, have an Event Registration Number (ERN), or have a Miscellaneous Certification Number (MCN)
